The Association: IAWV

The activities of the association include strengthening the state chapters, publishing national and state level directories of its members, prepare identity cards for its members and organize national level meetings for the empowerment of lady veterinarians all over the country.

The Host Institute: CVSc

The College of Veterinary Science, Khanapara under Assam Veterinary and Fishery University is a leading institute of Veterinary education in the North-Eastern part of India. The College is endowed with excellent teaching and research faculties to guide scholars in fundamental and applied aspects in Veterinary and Animal science. The college has rendered services in the promotion of Veterinary education and development of human resources since its inception in 1948. The college is 5 km from Dispur, the capital of Assam, 12 km from the Guwahati Railway Station and 32 km from the Lokapriya Gopinath Bordoloi International Airport, Borjhar.

The Host City: Guwahati

Guwahati, the gateway to North-East India is a captivating destination known for its mystic charm and perfect venue to experience the diverse culture of this region. The city is well connected with all the major cities of India. The river Brahmaputra flows down west touching the foot of the Blue Hill, Nilachal atop where stands the famous temple of Maa Kamakhya. The Kaziranga National Park, a world heritage site by UNESCO famous for one-horned rhinoceros is 200 km from Guwahati. Another nature lover's paradise Pobitora Wild Life Sanctuary, known for highest density of rhinoceros is just 40 km from Guwahati. To the southern part of the city about 80 km is the capital of Meghalaya, Shillong which is famous for its lush green landscapes, misty mountains, gorgeous vistas, colonial charm and vibrant cultural heritage.

Weather, Transport and Accommodation

Weather during the conference is expected to be mildly cold (Average Temperature 15-28°C) and might require light woollens. Cab services are available at the airport and Guwahati Railway Station. Deluxe air-conditioned bus services operated by the Assam State Transport Corporation is also available. Accommodation will be arranged in the University Guest House or hotels on **early bird registration** basis. Delegates are requested to send their travel plan well in advance for availing a convenient accommodation.

THEME OF THE CONFERENCE: Role of Women Veterinarians in Strengthening One Health through Innovations in Animal Husbandry, Clinical Practices and Wildlife Domain

Veterinarians play a pivotal role in advancing the One Health approach, which promulgates the integration of human, animal and environmental health. The conference theme underscores the multidimensional contributions of women veterinarians that drive strategic innovations in sustainable farming, biosecurity and preventive health programs that are indispensable for controlling the risks of zoonotic diseases thereby enhancing animal welfare and productivity. In the arena of diagnostic advancements women vets have contributed in numerous ways spanning from telemedicine, point-of-care diagnostics, zoonotic disease, surveillance by teaming up with public health professionals. A vital contribution of lady vets has been recorded in wildlife sector



too in various aspects of conservation, forensics, disease surveillance and preventing transmission of zoonotic pathogens. In essence, women veterinarians through their focused and dedicated efforts have been fostering interdisciplinary collaboration addressing both animal and human health challenges and thus promoting global health security holistically.

Submission of Abstracts/Papers

Original abstracts (not more than 350 words) for oral as well as poster presentation are invited for various technical sessions of the conference. Abstracts must be computer typed in MS-word Times New Roman font, size 12 and 1.5 spaced. The abstract should contain a title, name of authors along with affiliations and key words (3 to 5). The presenting author must be indicated by her name underlined along with mailing address. The preferred scientific and technical session should be mentioned on the top of the abstract. The abstract should be submitted only by email to abstract.iawv2025@gmail.com. The last date of submission of abstracts and invited papers is 10th November, 2025. Abstracts submitted after due date shall not be included in the compendium. It is mandatory for the presenting author to register in the convention. Registration can be done by filling the Google form. Once registration is completed, a registration ID no. will be sent by mail. Participants can submit the abstracts by mentioning the registration ID no. at the top left corner of the abstract. Participation in the conference is open for only women scientists, teachers, researchers, students, field veterinarians and corporate personnels. Delegates are requested to register early (on or before 31st October, 2025) for booking a convenient accommodation.
